Chinese Government Scholarship

2017-07-21

For the purpose of cultivating qualified Chinese and facilitating international promotion of Chinese language and dissemination of Chinese culture, Confucius Institute Headquarters/Hanban (hereinafter referred to as Hanban) launches a 'Confucius Institute Scholarship' program, entrusting Confucius Institutes (independent Confucius Classrooms) and some Chinese language testing centers (hereinafter referred to as Recommending Institutions) to recommend outstanding foreign students, scholars and Chinese language teachers to study in relevant universities of China (hereinafter referred to as Host Institutes).

Full scholarship covers tuition fee, accommodation fee, living allowance (except four weeks advanced students, BTC SOL, One-Academic-Year Study, One-Semester Study: RMB2,500 per month, MTCSOL: RMB3,000 per month) and comprehensive medical insurance expenses.

Partial scholarship covers tuition fee, accommodation fee and comprehensive medical insurance expenses.

The degree scholarship program applicants are subject to annual academic performance review. Only those who achieve outstanding records in academic and Chinese language proficiency are entitled to a full scholarship for the following year.

General Requirements

Application is open to applicant who owns a non-

Chinese citizenship, aged between 16 and 35, in good health condition, (Applicant is currently working in a Chinese language teaching position shall not exceed the age limit of 45. Undergraduate student shall not exceed the age limit of 20).

The scholarship is divided into 6 categories:

1. Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (MTCSOL)

Scholarship coverage and requirements:

Full scholarship: a minimum score of 210 in HSK Test (Level 5), and HSKK certificate (Intermediate Level)

Partial Scholarship: a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 5), and HSKK certificate (Intermediate Level)

Who provides a notarized employment agreement with an educational institution after graduation will be given preferential treatment.

Duration: Two academic years

Intake time: September, 2017

2. Bachelor's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (BTC SOL)

Scholarship coverage and requirements:

Full scholarship: a minimum score of 210 in HSK Test (Level 4), and HSKK certificate (Intermediate Level)

Partial scholarship: a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 4), and HSKK certificate (Intermediate Level)

Registered students in Confucius Institute or class will be given preferential treatment.

Duration: Four academic years

Intake time: September, 2017

3. One-Academic-Year Students.

International students who are studying in China from January 1, 2017 are not eligible for the scholarship.

Duration: 11 months

3.4 Chinese Philosophy

Target applicants: Students or scholars who aspire to Chinese language translation or research

Full or partial scholarship. minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 4), and HSK certificate(intermediate level).

4. One-Semester Students

Applicant should have no prior experience of studying in China

Duration: Five months

Intake time: Intake time: September, 2017 or March ,2018

4.1 Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages

Target applicants: Working Chinese language teachers, registered Confucius Institute or class students prepare for BTSCOL or students majored in Chinese language.

Full scholarship. a minimum score of 210 in HSK Test (Level 3), and HSKK report .

4.2 Taichi culture

Target applicants: Anyone who aspire to promote Chinese culture and with relevant studying experience and HSK report.

4.3 Traditional Chinese Medical Science

Target applicants: Anyone who aspire to promote Chinese culture and with relevant studying experience and HSK report.

4.4 Chinese Language & Literature

Target applicants: Students or scholars who majored in Dissemination of Chinese Language or relevant.

Full or partial scholarship. minimum score of 210 in HSK Test (Level 3), and HSKK report.

4.5 Chinese History

Target applicants: Students or scholars who majored in Dissemination of Chinese Language or relevant.

Full or partial scholarship. minimum score of 210 in HSK Test (Level 3), and HSKK report.

4.6 Chinese Philosophy

Target applicants: Students or scholars who majored in Dissemination of Chinese Language or relevant.

Full or partial scholarship. minimum score of 210 in HSK Test (Level 3), and HSKK report.

5. Four-Weeks Students

Full scholarship. Applicant should have no prior experience of studying in China and with HSK report.

Duration: Four weeks

Intake time: Intake time: July, 2017 or September ,2017

Target applicants: Advanced Chinese language teachers.

5.2 Taichi culture

Target applicants: registered Confucius Institute students or teachers

5.3 Traditional Chinese Medical Science

Target applicants: Team of registered Confucius Institute or class students (10-15 only)

6. South Asian Chinese Language Teachers

Target applicants: Chinese language teachers from 7 south Asian countries: Bangladesh, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Afghanistan, Maldives and India.

6.1 Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (MTCSOL)

Not exceed the age limit of 35, with bachelor degree or equivalent. a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 5), and HSKK certificate (Intermediate Level). Need to sign the agreement with Hanban. Who provides an employment agreement with a educational institution after graduation or relevant credentials will be given preferential treat. Meet the host institutions' requirements.

Duration: Two academic years

6.2 Bachelor's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (BTCSCOL)

and one year foundation plus BTCSCOL(1+4)

Not exceed the age limit of 25, with high school diploma. a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 3), and a minimum score of 60 in HSKK certificate (Intermediate Level). Need to sign the agreement with Hanban. Meet the host institutions' requirements.

Duration: Four or five academic years

6.3 Intensive Chinese Language training(One academic year or a semester) Applicant is currently student majoring in Chinese language or relevant. No prior experience of studying in China . For one academic year, a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 3), and a minimum score of 60 in HSKK certificate (beginner Level). For one semester, a minimum score of 120 in HSK Test (Level 2), and a minimum score of 60 in HSKK certificate (beginner Level). Meet the host institutions' requirements.

Duration: Eleven or five months

Application Procedure

Step 1. Please log on to the Confucius Institute Scholarships website (<http://cis.chinese.cn>) to register, search for recommendation institutions and host institutions, complete the Confucius Institute Scholarships Application Form online, and upload the scanned copies of relevant supporting documents.

Step 2. Keep an eye on the application process through the registered account to get the result of documents review and scholarship award.

Step 3. Scholarship winners confirm the admission process with the host institutions and print the award letter online.

Step 4. Come to China to Study.

Hanban will finish scholarship review two months ahead of the intake.

Those who won 2017 Confucius Institute scholarship in the Chinese language bridge contest do not need to apply online.

Supporting documents

General documents

1. Copy of Passport. If applicants under 18, their parents need to entrust permanent foreigners or Chinese to be applicants' guardian and submit notarized guardian's letter.
2. Scanned copies of HSK and HSKK transcript report(valid for two years)
3. Recommendation letter from the person in charge from recommendation Institutions(Objectively evaluation of applications and confirmation if he or she a student of Confucius institute or other identity. Currently Chinese language teachers should provide employment certificate and school recommendation letters)

Applicants for degree program should provide other two documents:

1. Notarized highest diploma certificate or expected graduation certificate and transcript.
2. Those who apply for MTCSOL need to provide two recommendation letters from associate professors or above. Who provides a notarized employment agreement with a educational institution after graduation will be given preferential treat.

Please consult the host institutions if other documents are needed.
